All The Right Type 3 Plus

ERAC has reached an agreement with Ingenuity Works to provide member districts with All The Right Type 3 Plus. There is no cost to districts or schools for this license. All The Right Type 3 Plus is a new, enhanced version of the software provided by the Ministry of Education in 2002.

Summary

All The Right Type 3 Plus (ATRT) is an enhanced keyboarding program compatible with newer operating systems and designed for use in schools. All The Right Type 3 Plus uses a classroom-tested methodology to develop keyboarding skills. Realistic posture and finger positions demonstrate correct fingering. Business education teachers will appreciate timed writings. Students work at their own pace, allowing teachers to monitor posture and technique. The record-keeping system frees teachers from marking and provides valuable feedback to students.

Pricing

There is no cost to districts, schools or teachers for ATRT 3 Plus. This ERAC agreement covers the use of the software in schools and for teachers to install on their personal computers. The agreement does not permit the provision of copies of the software to students for home use. Details

All The Right Type 3 Plus includes a number of enhancements to the previous version, including multimedia, sound, music, narration and other reinforcements to maintain students' attention and keep them motivated to develop their keyboarding skills. From past experience Ingenuity Works has collected a list of features and content that teachers are looking for in a keyboarding program for grades 3-6 that the previous existing version did not have, while still leaving it appropriate for adult learners. This version of ATRT has a number of technical upgrades and will operate and function with the new Microsoft and Apple operating systems.

BC schools use ATRT to support the Applied Skills curriculum. This offer is licensed for networking and stand-alone applications. It includes home use for teachers, lesson plans, posture diagram and keyboard layout charts for course instruction.

To download the program and obtain an installation guide follow the three steps below:

1. Record the activation code required to install the program from the members only announcement posted under "Software", "Active Software Initiatives" on the ERAC website www.bcerac.ca. The activation code is confidential to members.
2. Go to the Ingenuity Works/ERAC website www.ingenuityworks.com/bcerac and click on the ATRT icon; then, click the "Registration" link. Fill out the registration form and agree to the Terms and Conditions.
3. Download the product. Unzip the program and click on the "set-up icon". A welcome screen will prompt you to enter the activation code. A copy of the user's manual is available as a PDF in the teacher's All The Right Type program folder.
